

## **Okanagan Springs Pale Ale**

- Clear and copper coloured. It is fruity on the palate and hearty in hops with a nice round finish. It is BC's most popular craft beer

## **Tequila Cazadores**

### **Cazadores Reposado**

- For drinking in classic tequila cocktails like margaritas
- Reposado gets its name from being aged for over 2 months in new, small American white oak barrels, most often tequila is aged in old used bourbon barrels
- 100% blue agave

### **Cazadores Anejo**

- Anejo means aged
- Cazadores is aged 100% blue agave tequila
- This isn't your grandpa's tequila
- Aged at least 18 months up to 3 years in small new American white oak barrels
- It is designed as a sipping tequila

## **Nosing Tequila**

- Clean palate with water
  - Anejo is aged up to 3 years in small new American Barrels
  - Colour: amber and gold reflections – crisp and brilliant
  - Swirl – Note slow legs indicates full body
  - Aroma – nose above glass – notes of dried fruits, or cherry or you can perceive notes of the wood such as vanilla, chocolate or coffee
- 1) Take a sip
  - 2) Draw air into your mouth
  - 3) Exhale vapours through your nose
  - 4) Swallow
  - 5) Exhale remaining vapours through your mouth
  - 6) Balances sweetness, acidity and bitterness, its creamy in your mouth – very pleasant
